

2023 Tell Me Something Good – Physical Education Sweepstakes FAQ

Q: What is the 2023 Tell Me Something Good Physical Education Sweepstakes?

A: A Dairy MAX sweepstakes for Physical Education/Health teachers within the Dairy MAX territory (Texas, Colorado, Montana, Western Oklahoma*, New Mexico, Wyoming, Southwest Kansas** and Louisiana) to reward physical education and health teachers for continuing to find creative ways to promote health and wellness to their students.

Q: Who can apply for the 2023 Tell Me Something Good Physical Education Sweepstakes?

A: Entry is open to any staff member of a Physical Education Department at a school located in the Dairy MAX region (see below) that participates in USDA's National School Lunch and/or National School Breakfast Program and who is at least 18 years of age at the time of entry.

Q: How long are submissions being accepted?

A: The application opens Monday, January 16th, 2023 at 12:00am CST. The Deadline to submit is Friday, February 10th, 2023. Entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. CST on Friday, February 10th, 2023.

Q: How can I enter?

- A: **To Enter:** Submit your story via the <u>Submittable application</u>, and include the following items:
 - Up to 3 photos of your child nutrition team in action (JPG or PDF)
 - Description of photo
 - If a student's face is shown in the photo, a "<u>Signed Photo Release</u>" must be submitted for each student pictured. Submission will not be complete if the necessary student Photo Release is not received.

A free account must be created on Submittable before a submission can be completed. Number of photos submitted does not influence odds of winning.

To win: Winners will be determined by random drawing of all eligible entries. Winners will be selected on Friday, February 17th, 2023. Winners will be notified by Wednesday February 22nd, 2023. Winners must confirm acceptance of the prize by Wednesday, March 1st, 2023. In the event a winner declines the Prize, a second random drawing will be conducted to select a new winner for that NFL Market. If a second winner also declines to accept the Prize, a third winner will be drawn. If three winners are drawn and they all decline, the Prize will not be awarded.

Q: What is the 2023 Tell Me Something Good Physical Education Sweepstakes Prize?

A: One (1) winner per NFL market within the Dairy MAX region*** (total of four (4) winners) will receive an electronic gift card from U.S. Games valued at \$1,000. Upon acceptance of prize winners will work with their Dairy MAX and U.S. Games representatives to use the electronic gift card towards purchase of physical education equipment, materials or activities that support student physical education. The gift card must be used by Monday, May 30st, 2023. If not used by Monday, May 30st, 2023 winners forfeit the prize.
