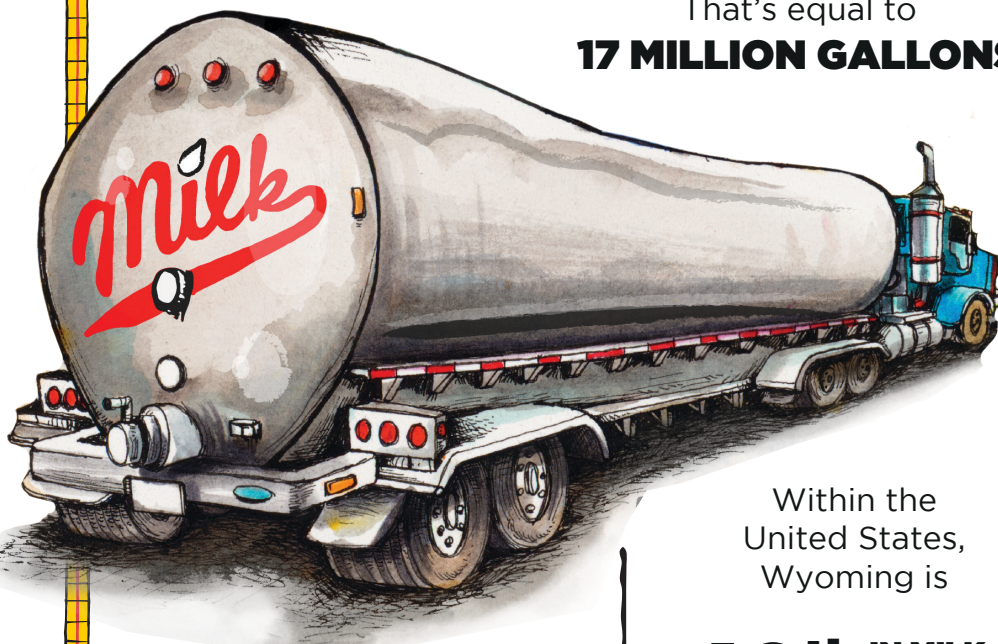
Which places Wyoming
